

How to Get Your 2018 Columbia Land Conservancy Fishing Permit

Steps:

1. Provide CLC with a copy of your current NYS Fishing License and Driver's License (a clear cell phone picture is acceptable as well).
2. Look over and sign the Fishing Monitor agreement and return with other materials.
3. Pay the \$5 individual permit fee (**payable by cash/check/money order made out to CLC only**), or support CLC by contributing as a member at the \$25 level or higher. (good for 2 adults and children 21 and under, and can be processed as a credit/debit card payment)
4. After these steps are completed please send all materials to Nate Davis at 49 Main Street Chatham, NY 12037 or scan and email them to nate.davis@clctrust.org. **If you can't scan and email or mail us your form and payment, Tuesdays and Thursdays between 9am and 4pm will be the only available times to get your permit at the CLC office in Chatham.**

All questions should be directed to Nate Davis, at 518.392.2546 or email above. Upon receiving all the requested materials, your permit(s) will be mailed out and you will be permitted to fish at Hand Hollow, High Falls, Ooms, Siegel-Kline Kill and Schor Conservation Areas from April 1 to December 31.
