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Nature Quest is a fun, interactive way to explore the trails! Just look for the Nature Quest symbol to start your adventure.

Meadow Loop Trail - 0.6 miles

Flat, open grass path in meadow. Some tree coverage along stream. Less than 1% grade, wide enough to walk side by side.

Hawk Hill Trail - 0.2 miles

Open grass path with a short incline (8% grade) up a hill. Wide enough to walk side by side. Bench at scenic view. Hill used for sledding in winter.

Stream Spur Trails - Less than 0.1 miles

Narrow, flat, packed earth trail with some exposed roots. Loose and often wet rocks along stream. Forested. Less than 1% grade.

Bluebird Trail - 0.2 miles

Open, flat grass path through a meadow. Wide enough to walk side by side. Less than 1% grade.

Trails may be muddy or icy during wet weather. Some trails may have standing water after heavy rain.
